
Charming 17th Century thatched country inn close to

EAST OF BRIDPORT

Travelling east from Bridport, the River Bride can be traced from Burton Bradstock to its source at Little Bredy. Whilst to the north the River Asker starts at Askerwell and eventually becomes the river Brit which powers the brewery's historic water wheel. Both valleys are dotted with picturesque village pubs and inns.






BRIDPORT OVERHAND LOOP

WEST OF BRIDPORT

North west of Bridport lies the Marshwood Vale. Made up of dozens of small farms, the Vale is a Hardyesque patchwork of fields and homesteads. Dotted around its perimeter can be found villages and hamlets which contain quintessential West Dorset pubs.



BEAMINSTER AND BACK AGAIN

This picturesque circular walk starts and finishes in Beaminster where you can find the Red Lion and Greyhound pubs on the main square. It takes in the traditional village pubs, the New Inn, Stoke Abbott and Hare & Hounds, Waytown. Between Waytown and Beaminster the route follows the River Brit past the quintessential West Dorset village of Netherbury. For those who want to stretch their legs a little further the route can be extended to take in the White Lion Broadwindsor which adds another 2.4 miles

ASCENT 330m
CIRCA 3.5 hours

As a circular walk there are numerous start and finish points. There are several parking options in Beaminster or at the New Inn, or Hare & Hounds which have good sized car parks that are available to use before dinner or after lunch.



DORSET DOWNS

The Dorset Downs are a chalk downland that extend from Beaminster Down in the west right across the county to Cranborne Chase. The area has a rich history of country pursuits and many of our pubs in the area have fabulous rooms that are the perfect base from which to explore the countryside.




